(1) ELIGIBILITY	
Gender	Female
Age limit	<p>Ladies who are 22 as of 1st April of the year of competition with a minimum Handicap Index of 18.5</p> <p>Junior Girls up to the age of 21 as of 1st April of the year of competition who have a Handicap Index of between 18.5 and a 27.0</p>
Amateur/professional status	Amateur
Handicap Limits	Minimum Handicap Index Limit 18.5

COMPETITION NAME	Ladies Bronze Vase Competition
Handicap Record	A Player must have a Handicap Index
Membership Category	Only members of South Moor Golf Club paying a full subscription (including Honorary, Concessionary, Secondary, Special and FES members)
Residence or membership status	Where the player is a member of South Moor Golf Club
Eligibility Requirements for Players with Disabilities to use Rule 25	Player must supply a Medical Certificate
Caddies	A player must not have a caddie during the round
(2) ENTRY REQUIREMENTS AND DATES	
Opening and Closing Dates and Times for Entry.	Entries for the competition open at 6pm on the Friday 2 weeks prior to the competition date. Entries for the competition close at 2pm on the day of the competition
Method of entry	Entries must be made online using the IG App. Players must check-in using the touchscreen in the bar and print off a scorecard label. Players must have paid the entry fee before commencing play.
How an entry fee is to be paid	Entry fees will be paid from members' golf bar account at the time of entry

Procedures to be used in determining the field when the competition is oversubscribed	There is no limit to the number of entries for this competition
(3) FORMAT	
Date and time of play	As stated on IG App – Players must use IG for correct tee-time. (BRS will be updated on a regular basis)
Bad weather policy.	If the course is unplayable on the day of the competition, then the competition will be re-arranged to play at a later date in the season if time permits. All players will be withdrawn from the competition and all entry fees will be refunded to member's bar account.

(5) WHEN A SCORECARD HAS BEEN RETURNED	
How scorecards are to be returned.	Scorecards must be posted into the locked scorecard box in the clubhouse foyer or handed to a member of the Competitions Committee. Cards must be returned promptly after play.
Other information requested on scorecards	Players should enter their scores via the touchscreen in the bar or via the IG App before officially returning their scorecard.

(6) HOW TIES WILL BE DECIDED	
Match play	N/A
Stroke play	All ties shall be decided on the last 9, 6, 3 or 1 holes. The last holes refer to holes 10-18. If a tie still arises it shall be decided by reference to the last 6, 3 or 1 holes of the first 9 holes. If this process does not produce a winner, the competition will be considered a tie.
